Washakie County School District #1, Worland, Wyoming, is accepting applications for a superintendent of schools. The successful candidate should demonstrate successful teaching, management, administrative and instructional leadership skills and possess high moral character to inspire and lead a school district that expects and supports a comprehensive educational program for its students. Salary will be commensurate with education and experience at an amount not less than \$130,000. Compensation will include a comprehensive benefits package. The successful applicant must live within the district after hire.

Worland is nestled in the foothills of the beautiful Big Horn Mountains. It is centrally located in northern Wyoming. Travelers from the east will embark on the Big Horn Mountains via Cloud Peak Skyway (U.S. Hwy. 16). The Big Horns offer the outdoor enthusiast summer activities including boating, fishing, hiking, picnicking, photography, fossil hunting, camping, and peaceful moments in wilderness areas. The scenery is absolutely outstanding! This is the same land that was precious to native Americans. In the fall and winter months, the mountain land offers pleasant treks by snow machine or by skis, both cross-country, and downhill. Meadowlark Ski Lodge offers fast, easy runs for the downhill athlete. Prime cross-country ski trails are located nearby at Willow Park. Wildlife abounds in the region and big game hunting is a popular activity for both locals and nonresident sportsmen. Along our travel route the amazing geography changes from mountains to badlands between Ten Sleep and Worland on Highway 16. This area, in fact, had been covered by water during its history. Many fish and amphibious fossils have been uncovered, revealing the true diversity of this area.

Washakie County School District #1 covers the western side of Washakie County with attendance centers in Worland. The district serves approximately 1,150 students in five schools including three elementary schools, one middle school, and one high school. The district also offers a K-12 online program. The district offers a comprehensive educational program for students in grades kindergarten through 12.
